Objective: Draw a picture of yourself reading a book. At the bottom of your picture, print a short explanation of what you like to read. Examples: "I like to read about bulldozers." "Scary books are my favorite." "I like stories that are full of adventures." You can include drawings that illustrate your favorite things. Be sure that both your drawing and writing are as clear and neat as you can make them.

Limit: One entry per student.

Preparation of entries: The base surface should be paper **NO LARGER** than 11 x 17 inches. For the sake of reproduction, entries should be drawn with dark crayons or felt-tipped markers, if possible. You may want to suggest to students that they draw in pencil, and then go over it in marker.

The following information must be provided on the back of each entry:

Student's name

Grade

Teacher name

School

NIEW liaison responsible for handling the contest at your school

Awards: First-place winner will receive a check for \$30; second-place, \$20; third-place, \$10. These three winning entries will be reproduced in the Design-an-Ad supplement in the Tuesday, March 5, issue of The Republican-Herald.

Deadline: Entries must undergo preliminary judging at the school. Top entries must arrive at The Republican-Herald no later than Tuesday, January 8, to allow time for final judging and production work.
